

# **Al Features Addendum**

This Al Features Addendum ("Al Terms") is added to and forms part of the applicable End User License Agreement, Master Subscription Agreement, or other agreement in place between Customer and Leapwork governing access to and use of the Leapwork products ("Agreement"), as additional terms. These Al Terms apply specifically to the use of Leapwork's "Al Blocks" and other Al components (collectively, "Al Features") integrated into the Leapwork software. Any capitalized terms used but not defined below have the meanings in the Agreement. Any capitalized terms also used in the Agreement will for the purposes of these Al Terms supersede the definition in the Agreement.

- **1 Definitions.** The following additional definitions apply:
  - "AI Features": Refers to any artificial intelligence or machine learning functionality integrated into Leapwork software that can generate, suggest, or assist in generating content, recommendations, code, or other outputs based on user input.
  - "Al Input": Any data, content, or information provided by Customer or its Authorized Users when using the Al Features, including but not limited to inputs, prompts, and gueries.
  - "Al Output": Any data, content, or information generated by the Al Features in response to Al Input, such as a test automation script.
  - "Authorized Users": Individuals who are authorized by Customer to use the Leapwork products, including the Al Features, in accordance with the Agreement.

## 2 Use of Al Features

- 2.1 **Prohibited Uses.** Customer and its Authorized Users shall not use the Al Features:
- 2.1.1 In any manner that violates applicable laws or regulations, including but not limited to laws related to privacy, data protection, and intellectual property.
- 2.1.2 To process or generate sensitive personal data, including but not limited to data related to health, race, ethnicity, political opinions, religious beliefs, sexual orientation, or biometric data, unless expressly supported in a written agreement between you and Leapwork.
- 2.1.3 For any malicious, harmful, or unethical purposes, including generating misleading information, spreading disinformation, or infringing on others' rights.
- 2.2 Permitted Uses. Customers and Authorized Users may use the Al Features to automate workflows, enhance testing processes, generate recommendations, and assist with content creation or coding within the bounds of the Agreement. Permitted uses include:
- 2.2.1 Automating routine tasks such as generating test automation scripts.
- 2.2.2 Using Al-generated insights to improve operational efficiency.
- 2.2.3 Leveraging Al-generated content for internal purposes, provided it complies with all applicable laws and regulations.

- 2.3 **Best Practices.** When using the AI Features, Customers and Authorized Users should:
- 2.3.1 Ensure that all inputs provided to the Al Features are lawful, non-sensitive, and free of personally identifiable information unless otherwise agreed upon.
- 2.3.2 Regularly review and verify Al Outputs for accuracy and compliance with internal policies and legal requirements.
- 2.3.3 Use the Al Features as a supplement to human judgment, rather than relying solely on Al for critical decisions.

### 3 Use and Ownership of Input and Output

- 3.1 **Ownership of Al Input:** Customer retains ownership of, and is responsible for, all Al Input processed when using the Al Features. This includes ensuring Customer grants Leapwork a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use, reproduce, and process the Customer Data solely for the purpose of providing and improving the Al Features.
- 3.2 Ownership of Al Output: Subject to Leapwork's ownership of the Al Features and underlying models, Customer shall have a license to use, modify, and distribute the Al Output, provided that such use complies with these Al Terms and the Agreement. Customer acknowledges that Al Output may not be unique and that similar output may be generated for other customers.
- 3.3 **Responsibility for Use**: Customer is solely responsible for the use of the Al Output and any decisions or actions taken based on such output. Leapwork disclaims any responsibility or liability for the consequences of Customer's use of the Al Output.

### 4 Warranties and Disclaimers

- 4.1 **No Warranty:** The AI Features are provided "as-is" without any warranties, express or implied, including but not limited to warranties of accuracy, reliability, non-infringement, fitness for a particular purpose, or that the AI Features will meet Customer's specific requirements.
- 4.2 **Limitations**: Leapwork does not guarantee that the Al Output will be accurate, complete, or error-free. Customer acknowledges that Al-generated content may contain errors or inaccuracies and should not be relied upon without independent verification.
- 4.3 **Indemnification**: Customer agrees to indemnify and hold Leapwork harmless from any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of or related to Customer's use of the Al Features or Al Output in violation of these Al Terms or the Agreement.

#### 5 Additional Terms

- 5.1 **Order of Precedence**: If these AI Terms conflict with the Agreement, the AI Terms will take priority for any Alrelated issues.
- 5.2 Government Customers: If Customer is a government entity, the AI Features are provided as a commercial item, and all AI Output shall be treated as "Commercial Computer Software" or "Commercial Computer Software Documentation" as those terms are defined in applicable government procurement regulations. The rights of the government to use, modify, reproduce, release, perform, display, or disclose the AI Features or AI Output are limited by these AI Terms.

- 5.3 **Modifications**: Leapwork reserves the right to modify these Al Terms at any time. Such modifications will be effective upon notice to Customer, and continued use of the Al Features after such notice constitutes acceptance of the modified Al Terms.
- 5.4 **Termination**: Leapwork may suspend or terminate access to the Al Features if Customer or its Authorized Users violate these Al Terms or the Agreement. Upon termination, Customer must immediately cease all use of the Al Features and delete any Al Output that violates these Al Terms.
